

Wind River Crew Leader

Term dates: May 21 to Aug 17, 2018

Living allowance: \$700 biweekly

Education award: \$1,538.36 upon completion of the program

Overview: Serve as a Crew Leader in the Wind River, Wyoming Area! - Spend time working across varying landscapes in Wyoming engaging young adults from the Wind River Reservation area in outdoor natural resource projects.

Montana Conservation Corps will be partnering with multiple land management agencies to complete a variety of conservation projects from fencing to trail maintenance and more. There will also be opportunities to network and connect with land management agencies (e.g., U.S. Forest Service, National Park Service) to gain insight into and connections for future career pathways. As a Crew Leader, you will work alongside a co-leader overseeing a crew of (6) Eastern Shoshone and Northern Arapaho young adults from communities in and around the Wind River Indian Reservation . The crew will explore and complete project work in many locations, including Yellowstone National Park and Grand Teton National Park, providing an opportunity to engage in service projects on ancestral lands and to learn traditional knowledge.
