

Youth Crew Leaders - Indian Education for All

Term dates: May 21 to Aug 15, 2018

Living allowance: \$700 biweekly

Education award: \$1,538.36 upon completion of the program

Overview: Spend time across varied landscapes in Montana engaging native high school and middle school students in outdoor service learning activities. We are partnering with the Indian Education for All programs in the Billings and Great Falls schools to create an awesome outdoor summer experience for native teens. You will spend your time engaging these youth in outdoor conservation activities, connecting them with their ancestral lands as well as the agencies that oversee these lands. They will learn from public land agency professionals and tribal elders about habitat restoration, wildlife management, recreation management, and archaeology while exploring local lands with cultural significance and completing service projects to improve the lands. As a leader, you will work alongside a teacher and a co-leader. Activities will primarily be day projects but will include some overnight activities. Housing is not required as residential camping will be provided. Most student loans qualify for forbearance while participating in AmeriCorps. Additionally, upon successful completion of your term, you will earn an education award that can be used toward paying off qualifying student loans or for future education.
