

Crew Leader-Flagstaff-July 2017

Our July start Flagstaff, AZ-based conservation crews have a huge variety of great project work including Grand Canyon trails, Escalante Canyon (Utah) backcountry saw project doing invasive removal, Aravaipa Canyon restoration project, Walnut Canyon National Monument chainsaw fuels reduction, and many, many others. Applicants should indicate in their cover letter whether they are interested in leading a saw crew, trail crew, or both. Candidates should have strong people skills and previous corps experience.

Responsibilities: Supervise 7-8 person AmeriCorps crew to perform heavy manual labor related to environmental conservation and restoration projects; work outdoors in all types of weather and successfully adapt to various climates; camp overnight outdoors in wilderness areas near work sites for short or extended periods of time; effectively learn and apply new environmental conservation and restoration skills and outdoor living skills; actively participate in environmental education activities; practice appropriate safety procedures in all tasks assigned; use, maintain and repair hand and power tools as necessary.
