

## Blackfeet Crew Leader

The Blackfeet Crew Leader position is the perfect fit for someone interested in developing their leadership skills, enhancing relationships within the Blackfeet community, and positively impacting young adults and nearby ancestral lands.

**Leadership Training!** You will participate in MCC's Leadership Development Program (LDP) but with a twist. You can expect this version to have similarities to the traditional LDP, like trails training, and saw training, but there will also be several additions to enhance your cultural competency, knowledge of tribal history, and young adult behavior management.

**Community Building!** You will work with local community organizations, agencies, and educational institutions to build relationships within the Blackfeet community and to recruit members for the summer Blackfeet crew. This aspect of the position will be woven through the LDP.

**Field Work!** Upon successful completion of the first two components you and your co-leader will relocate to Browning, MT, the seat of the Blackfeet Nation, to lead nine weeks of field based projects. As a crew, you'll work with a variety of tribal, federal and non-profit partners to complete important natural resource management, cultural, and community service projects. Project partners include the Blackfeet Nation, Glacier National Park, the US Forest Service and more.
