Fall Crew Leader – Moab Field Office

The Utah Conservation Corps (UCC) is an AmeriCorps program dedicated to developing conservation leaders through service and education and improving the quality of public lands through partnership projects.

Position Description

The UCC Fall Crew Leader is a three-month AmeriCorps position that provides direct leadership to a 4-person field crew. Crew Leaders are responsible for preparing and leading their crew in the completion of conservation projects, as well as ensuring that UCC policies and procedures are followed, facilitating education time with their crew, communicating with project sponsors, and recording important project outcome data. Project schedules vary by crew and may include habitat restoration, trail building & maintenance, invasive species removal, re-vegetation, fence building, and forest fuels reduction.

Field crews generally camp near their project site during the project week and return to their field office location for off time between project weeks.

The UCC Fall Crew Leader position is an AmeriCorps term requiring a three-month commitment, which includes three weeks of training and ten weeks of project work.

Qualifications

- Previous conservation corps or similar land management experience
 - Chainsaw experience (B Faller or equivalent), preferred
 - Trail maintenance and construction experience, preferred
- Previous leadership or supervisory experience
- Demonstrated outdoor skills
 - Camping experience, including backpacking

Requirements

- Flexibility and desire to work in a dynamic environment
- Ability to work an irregular schedule
- Ability and desire to work in a variety of weather conditions
- Maturity and good attitude
- At least 21 years of age
- U.S. Citizen or Permanent Resident
- Proof of a valid driver's license
- Eligible to enroll in AmeriCorps

- Americorps Education Award, \$1,527 (available upon successful completion of term)
- Forbearance on qualifying student loans while in service
- Valuable conservation leadership and field experience
- Working on a professional level with land management agency personnel
